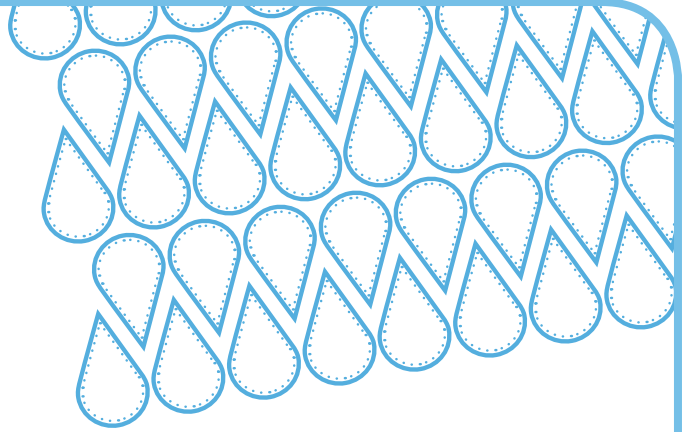


URBAN INFORMATION CARD DECK WHAT? HOW?



The Urban Information Card Deck was designed to inspire and to give ideas for using urban information.

Cards consist of selected citizens' practices related to urban information. Material was collected in mapping practices sessions with urban activists and app developers in Helsinki in autumn 2013.

The card deck does not cover every single aspect of urban information, but it is rooted tightly into citizen's everyday lives; what kind of urban information they need, want to use, and are interested of.

The use of urban information has been divided into five categories; HOW, FROM WHERE, WHAT, WHERE, and TO WHERE. A card can belong to one or more categories simultaneously. In addition, the deck includes IDEA cards, and also there is one card named WHOSE INFORMATION. Idea cards are for inspiration, whose information card is meant to remind that information is always possessed by someone. There are also several empty cards, which can be used to write down your own thoughts and ideas to supplement the deck.
